

Suicide Prevention Language Guide

Issue

Language that presents suicide as a **desirable outcome**.

Phrases that associate suicide with **crime, sin, or wrongdoing**.

Language that **glamorizes** a suicide **attempt**.

Phrases that **sensationalize** suicide.

Gratuitous use of the term **'Suicide' out of context**.

Incorrect

Terms such as **'Successful Suicide'** or **'Unsuccessful Suicide.'**

Phrases such like **'Commit suicide,'** or **'Committed suicide.'**

Using phrases like **'Failed suicide'** implies that a fatal attempt would be **'Successful.'**

Phrases such as **'Suicide epidemic.'**

Using terms such as **'Suicide mission,'** **'Political suicide,'** or in sports, **'Suicide pass.'**

Correct

Instead say, **'Took their own life,'** **'Ended their own life,'** or **'Died by suicide.'**

Again, instead use the phrases above such as **'Ended their own life.'**

Instead say, **'Made an attempt on their life,'** **'Suicide attempt,'** or **'Non-fatal attempt.'**

Use phrases such as **'Higher rates,'** **'Increasing Rates,'** or **'Concerning data.'**

Refrain from using the word **'Suicide'** **out of context.**
